

**TOUR NOTE OF ABHISHEK SINGH, IAS, DM & COLLECTOR, DHALAI DISTRICT FOR
VISIT TO THE DUMBUKNAGAR RD BLOCK**

26.09.2012:

I visited Dumburnagar RD Block on 26th September, 2012 to have Block level meeting with the officials and PRI members as well as to make field inspections. During the visit SDM, Gandacherra, BDO, Dumburnagar, SA, Gandacherra and Range Officer of Forest department accompanied me to Narikel Kunj. BDO, Dumburnagar is requested to issue minutes for the meeting held with line departments separately. However, the major issues highlighted during the visit are mentioned here for necessary action by the concerned.


1. The joint survey by the Water Resource and the Agriculture department should be completed and the report should be ready by 15th October, 2012 positively. The WR department shall follow-up with TSECL for energization of two numbers of LI schemes and one number of deep tube-well this month. Further, EE, WR, Kamalpur shall ensure that the feasibility analysis for the new sources wherever demanded/required should be immediately done and all the scheme should made functional by first week of October, 2012.
2. BDO, Dumburnagar shall issue necessary inspection to all the VC for taking of minor repairs/ maintenance of the drinking water sources and irrigation sources from the TFC fund with the technical support from the concerned department wherever required. However, the overall responsibility of the drinking water and the irrigation sources will remain with the concerned department. BDO, Dumburnagar shall take up the issue of approval of pump operators @ 60-card with Director, Panchayet department with copy to undersigned.
3. The DGM, TSECL shall prepare a separate project report for partly/uncovered habitation which would not be taken under RGGVY Phase-II and submit to the AGM, TSECL and undersigned by 15th October, 2012. The ongoing survey for providing connectivity to small bore deep tube-wells and other drinking water sources should be completed by 30th September, 2012.
4. DGM and the Sr. Manager, TSECL shall ensure that in no case the repair and maintenance of transformers takes more than 10 days without replacement. In case there is delay beyond 10 days a replacement (substitute transformer) should be provided.
5. The immunization percentage in Gandacherra is very low, 51% only in comparison to the district average of 81%. SDM, Gandacherra and SDMO, Gandacherra shall chalk out detailed action plan to improve immunization to more than 90% by March, 2013 and submit same to the undersigned and CMO by first week of October, 2012. They should ensure that the records available at the AWCs are properly utilized for the healthcare related activities and VHNDs are organized regularly.

6. The performance under MCTS particularly the registration of children has been extremely low and even for the pregnant mothers many of the columns are not filled up properly. SDM, Gandacherra is requested to look into the matter personally and ensure that MCTS properly implemented and updated in the Sub-Division. The ambulance available from MLA-LAD fund (BEUP) is still not being run by the SHG as directed to the memo of MD, NRHM, Government of Tripura. The SDM and SDMO, Gandacherra shall take necessary action at the earliest in this regard.
7. The report given by SDO, DWS, Gandacherra was found to be not correct and incomplete. The same should be immediately corrected and the details of coverage of habitations with count of source creation as well as action plan for the coverage of AWCs and schools should be put up and shared with undersigned, SDM, BDO and the PRIs. The copy of work order must be shared with the BDO and the concerned GP/VC. For schools and AWCs, the copy of work order should be shared with concerned I/S or CDPOs as the case may be.
8. The progress of construction of school toilets was found to be extremely slow and only 4 out of 108 toilets given under SSA were found to be constructed so far. SDO, DWS, Gandacherra could not give any satisfactory answer for such poor performance which has been below par than other blocks as well. EE, DWS shall issue show cause to the SDO, DWS, GNC with copy to the undersigned. SDM, Gandacherra shall withhold the drawl of salary from the Sub-Treasury for SDO, DWS, Gandacherra until further orders.
9. All the ICDS centres do not have pucca buildings yet. Out of 239, 75 numbers of AWCs have GCI sheet walling whereas another 9 are under construction. It was reported that 17 numbers of AWCs got damaged due to cyclone which should be immediately taken up for repair from the fund available under TFC/PDF. A separate report on above issues shall be submitted by DISE by 30th September, 2012.
10. The BDO, Dumburnagar shall take up the kitchen sheds from BRGF in those AWCs first which do not have separate room/additional room.
11. I/S, TTAADC reported that the teachers are not able to stay at Hatimata teachers' accommodation due to non-allowing of TSR to use the common road through the TSR camp up to the teachers' accommodation. SDM, Gandacherra shall take up the matter with SDPO, Gandacherra and concerned TSR Commandant to facilitate stay of teachers' at Hatimata.
12. The SDO, PWD (R&B) could not give the habitation wise details for connectivity other than PMGSY/Bharat Nirman. The district level committee with DM & Collector, SE, PWD(R&B) and SE, RD had finalized the list of habitations as well as the roads with unconnected habitations which would be covered by PMGSY/Bharat Nirman as well as MGNREGA/other schemes. BDO, Dumburnagar, SDO, PWD and Asstt. Engineer RD

(I/C) for Dumburnagar Block shall re-examine the connectivity to all the 216 habitations and submit a detailed report by first week of October, 2012 with respect to existing status as well as action plan to connect the balance habitations including the proposed habitations (+250) under PMGSY and (-250) habitations.

13. All the line departments shall finalize their projects to be taken in the 3rd and 4th quarters and submit to the Block Development Officer after getting it duly routed through GP/VC and ensuring that the same is the part of Annual Shelf of Project under MGNREGA 2012-13 within 1st week of October, 2012.
14. BDO, Dumburnagar shall closely monitor the base line survey being conducted under TSC/NBA and ensure that it is properly done and is completed by 10th October, 2012.
15. Thereafter, I visited the Narikel Kunj. It has been found that all the components of the development of Narikel Kunj as finalized in the 2010-11 by the Tripura Tourism Development Corporation have not been completed. BDO, Dumburnagar informed that due to delay in sanction in placement of fund all the component could not be taken up as the cost escalated. BDO shall submit a separate report with details for same.
16. SDM, Gandacherra and BDO, Dumburnagar are requested to work out a detailed project proposal for development of Narikel Kunj as a tourist destination along with water sport facility in the Dumburnagar Lake in consultation with Forest, ICAT, Agriculture, PWD and Power department. A report in this respect may be submitted by first week of October, 2012.

All concerned official shall take necessary action and submit action taken report within 15 days.
