

**TOUR NOTE OF SRI VIKAS SINGH, IAS, DISTRICT MAGISTRATE & COLLECTOR, DHALAI
TRIPURA TO GULAP VILLAGE ORGANIZATION (VO) IN JAGANATHPUR VC AMBASSA R.D.
BLOCK UNDER TRLM ON 19/08/2016.**

The undersigned visited Gulap VO along with Block Mission Coordinator, Ambassa at 4.00pm for reviewing the functioning of SHGs under Tripura Rural Livelihood Mission (TRLM) Project. Gulap VO was formed on 14th November, 2015 & consists of 6(six) nos. of SHG at a starting cost of Rs. 15,000/- per month only & Community Investment Fund (CIF) of Rs. 2,30,000/- only. During the visit the undersigned interacted with the members of 2(Two) nos. SHGs under Gulap VO.

1. Maya SHG : The SHG consisted of 3(three) signatories & 12(twelve) nos. of women members. On interacting with the members of the SHG, it was found that the SHG received an amount of Rs. 15,000/- as revolving fund (RF) under TRLM. The said amount was divided among 3(three) members out of 12 members. The said amount was utilized for Cattle Farm and Cultivation of Paan Crops. Further, the group also received a Community Investment Fund of Rs. 60,000/- only which was also utilized for similar activities as stated above. The average monthly income of the members of SHG is Rs. 2000-3000/- per month only. Further, they are also returning back an amount @ Rs. 1000- 2000/- per month to the VO.

2) Surja SHG: The SHG consists of 10(Ten) nos. of women members. The SHG was provided Rs. 10,000/- only as Revolving Fund (RF) and fund of Rs. 60,000/- only for CIF (Community Investment Fund). The SHG was found to be engaged in activities like buying of corn for rice milling, Grocery shop, Piggery cultivation, buying of vegetables & repair of Auto etc. The SHG group earned an average of Rs. 5000- 10,000/- per month and is also returning an amount @ Rs. 1000/- only back to the VO.

3) Hridhay SHG: The SHG has been formed recently with the 7(Seven) nos. of women members. The SHG has received revolving fund of Rs. 10,000/- only which has been utilized for activities such as grocery shop, piglet etc. The SHG is not eligible for Community Investment Fund (CIF) as of now.

During the interaction with the members of SHG, they requested to provide training to their members for skill development in areas such as soft toys making, tailoring, floriculture & pickle making etc. In this regard, it was assured that skill development under MGNREGA LIFE project for those members of SHGs who are having MGNREGA Job Card will be considered accordingly. PD, DRDA is hereby requested to prepare proposal in this regard for sending to UBI -RSETI for providing skill development training to the SHG members by 31-08-2016.



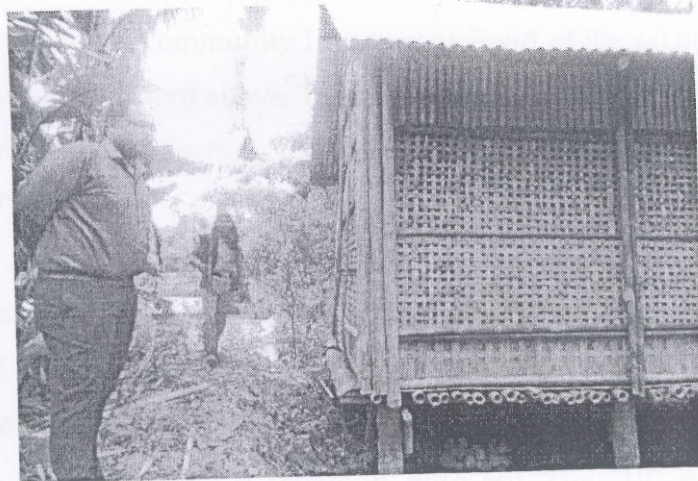
